8:45 AM: Start of the activity program:

• For sporty guests: Guided e-mountain bike tour to the "Konstanzer" Alpine hut





We start in St. Anton am Arlberg at the entrance to the beautiful Verwall valley. The ride to the Konstanzer hut, which lies at 1,688 m, is about 23 km and will take about 1,5 hours, with an elevation gain of 535 m. On our way there we will be rewarded with wonderful views of the Verwall lake and the Patteriol (3,056m). At the Konstanzer hut we will stop off and spoil ourselves for our efforts! The return to the starting point will take us over the "Sattelwaldweg". Appr. return to St. Christoph around 4 PM.

• For culture enthusiasts: Drive to Stams Monastery – visit the "Maximilian exhibition" and the 5 original documents of the brotherhood.





At 9: 45 AM, we start from the hotel with a bus and drive to Stams. There, the abbot, brother German Erd(member of the Brotherhood council) will guide us through the pen. We enjoy the emperor Maximilian exhibition (due to hist 500th death anniversary) and visit the five original documents of the Brotherhood from the years 1398 to 1427. The tour takes appr. 1,5 to 2 hours. After the tour there is the possibility to have lunch at the "Orangery" (on your own expenses). In addition, you can buy the in-house products of the monastery such as jams, honey, noble brandies and liqueurs. Return to St. Christoph about 3 PM.

6 PM: Cocktail and honoring for 25 years of loyal membership in the arlberg1800 Contemporary Art & Concert Hall and the presentation of the new brotherhood-movie.

Saturday, 13th July 2019

8:45 AM: Start of the activity program:

- For sporty guests: Alpine hike from St. Anton am Arlberg to the Moostal Sattelkopf (1.900m) via Alpe Tannun to the Verwall-Restaurant back via the Rosanna Goarch

 We start from the hotel with a transfer to St. Anton am Arlberg. At 9 AM we start our tour with a mountain guide. The ascent to the Sattelkopf is a moderate mountain hike of the ÖAV classification red. The route length is approx. 12,5and 650 m of altitude difference. The total walking time is about 6 hours. Good mountain boots and sure-footedness are required. We will return to St. Anton around 4 PM, where the transfer to St. Christoph will wait for us.
- For families: A gentle hike from St. Christoph via Maiensee to the Sennhut

 The route leads from St. Christoph via the Maiensee to St. Anton and is a pleasant half-day hike. The wonderful Maiensee lies on the way and invites one to relax and swim. There are many benches along the way to stop and enjoy the great views of the Arlberg mountain scenery. We will drop into the "Sennhütte" for refreshment and return to St. Christoph with the Postbus.
- For families and gourmets: Fishing with brother Florian Werner at the fish pond in Zug with lunch





Fishing gear and bait will be provided, as well as a few tips, so that nothing can stop us from catching our first fish. The self-caught trout or char will then be freshly prepared for us to eat. Return to St. Christoph at about 4 PM.
